
WHERE IS IT?

TWO ROUTE OPTIONS

FULL YETI • 100 miles

The Full Yeti will test each and every rider with over 12,000 feet of climbing. This route takes you high into the Uinta mountain range to the tip of Strawberry Reservoir and back before flying down to the finish in Heber Valley.




MINIYETI •35 miles


