4. Lunding Property / Revised Documents (Corbin Gordon, City Attorney – Approximately 30 minutes) – Discuss and possibly approve revised documents related to the Lundin property, located at 900 West Bigler Lane, and its preservation as open space.

Corbin Gordon made the following comments:

- The City had worked for a year to prepare acceptable terms for a conservation easement on the Lundins’ property.
- Received an email from the Lundins’ attorney indicating that no further action could be taken because a settlement agreement with Ronnie Lundin, a brother, and Terry Lundin, a sister-in-law, had expired.
- Did the Council want him to spend any more time on the issue?
- The Lundin family did not have the authority to enter into any agreements because the family’s settlement agreement had lapsed.
- Did not provide the updated documents to the Council.
- All the documents had been drafted but were not finalized because of the email from the Lundins’ attorney.

Wendy Fisher, Utah Open Lands Executive Director, made the following comments:

- Did not represent the Lundins.
- Acknowledge Mr. Gordon's time revising the needed documents.
- The parties were close to agreeing on terms to preserve the property as open space.
- The Lundins needed to know that there were final documents that all parties would sign.
- Requested several changes to the documents.
- The Lundin family would execute the documents when they had authority.
- Section 2.3 should state that the water rights were part of the conservation easement.
- Utah Open Lands would co-own but not directly own the water rights.

Note: Nora Lundin arrived at 6:18 p.m.

- Section 2.2.1 should clarify that the Lundins could pay back Wasatch County.
- Section 2.3.2 should clarify that Utah Open Lands would co-hold the water rights.
- Section 3.1 needed to include Ronnie and Terry.
- Section 4.5 should state that the Lundins could record the conservation easement as soon as they determined additional funds would not be available.
- Conceptually the documents could be finalized, executed by all parties, and Midway City and Wasatch County would pay their committed money to the Lundins. Ronnie and Terry would then be paid, and the rest of the family could seek additional funding.

Mr. Gordon made the following additional comments:

- Could update the documents with Ms. Fisher's changes.
- The City could not leave its offer open indefinitely.
- Did not want to go through more negotiations and have the Lundins refuse to sign the documents.
- Could finalize the documents in a form that the Council could approve.

Council Member Payne indicated that the documents should prohibit the Lundins from selling the associated water rights.

Nora Lundin made the following comments:

- Needed the City's help to complete the preservation of the property.
- Could not go back and ask Ronnie and Terry for more time.
- Mr. Gordon needed to indicate to the Lundins' attorney that executable documents were ready. Their attorney could then talk to Ronnie and Terry's attorney.
- Mr. Gordon needed to help Wasatch County complete the proposal.
- Thought that Ronnie and Terry would sign if they knew they would be paid within 48 hours.
- Wanted to have everything completed by Christmas but needed it done by the end of the year.

The Council, staff, and meeting attendees discussed the following items:

- Any timeline for completion needed to be accurate and met.
- Did the documents need to be brought back before the Council for approval? Mr. Gordon preferred that the documents be finalized and then brought back to the Council.
- The revised documents could be provided to John Woodard, Wasatch County Attorney's office. Mr. Gordon indicated that they could be finalized by the end of the week and then

provided to Mr. Woodard.

Mr. Gordon made the following additional comments regarding recent changes to the documents:

- References to the since resolved lawsuit regarding the property had been removed.
- The water rights would be held in escrow, but the Lundins would not sign the certificates.
- A notice of interest would be filed with the Midway Irrigation Company regarding the certificates. It would require both the City and the County to approve any changes to the water rights.
- If additional funding, including from the NRCS, was not received within three years and 180 days then the money paid by the City and County would be returned with interest and the conservation easement would be invalidated. Ms. Lundin clarified that after that time the conservation easement would be recorded. This would guarantee that the Lundins could not hold up the process.

Council Member Payne asked if the Council could approve the documents that evening and authorize the Mayor to sign them based on the discussion. Mr. Gordon responded that it could.

Mayor Johnson indicated that she would be available the next and then the following Mondays to sign the documents.

Mr. Gordon asked how long it would take the City to pay the Lundins. Brad Wilson thought 24 business hours.

Ms. Lundin said that she spoke to County Council Member Colleen Bonner who said the next County Council meeting would be in January. She again asked Mr. Gordon to work with the County to expedite the process. Mr. Gordon responded that he would work as quickly as possible.

Ms. Lundin thought that Ronnie and Terry would authorize the deal if they knew that they would be paid immediately. She did not think that executable documents would be enough of an incentive.

Motion: Council Member Payne moved to approve the documents based on the explanation given that evening and authorized the Mayor to sign them.

Second: Council Member Orme seconded the motion.

Discussion: Mayor Johnson noted that the County also had to approve the deal before the City should pay any money.

**RULING ON APPEAL OF
ADMINISTRATIVE DECISION
ON SITE DISTURBANCE PERMIT**

PROCEDURAL STATUS

1. Homestead Group LLC ("Homestead") applied for and was issued a Site Disturbance Permit by the Midway City Planning Department to conduct landscaping and site-related improvements on the existing Homestead golf course.
2. On or about September 15, 2025, the Planning Department issued the Site Disturbance Permit, determining that the proposed work qualified for such permit based on the continued lawful existence of the golf course.
3. Chalets on the Creek Homeowners Association ("Chalets") filed a timely appeal of the issuance of the Site Disturbance Permit, asserting that the Planning Department erred by failing to determine whether the golf course had been legally established prior to construction in or about 1989.
4. A hearing on the appeal was held before the Midway City Council sitting as the Land Use Appeal Authority, at which the City, Homestead, and Chalets were provided the opportunity to present argument and evidence.
5. The City Council has reviewed the appeal de novo, including the written appeal materials, the City's response, historical records, and the arguments presented at the hearing.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Homestead golf course was proposed and reviewed by the Midway City Council in 1987 under zoning then in effect, including R-1-A and R-4 zones.
2. On October 5, 1987, the City Council determined that a golf course was sufficiently similar to listed conditional uses within the applicable zoning districts and authorized Homestead to apply for a conditional use permit.
3. On November 5, 1987, following review, the Midway City Council approved a Conditional Use Permit authorizing construction and operation of the golf course.
4. On December 3, 1987, the City Council adopted Ordinance 87-4 creating the R-5 zone to allow residential development around the golf course. The golf course itself was not approved under the R-5 zone but had already been approved by conditional use.
5. Landscaping and grading associated with construction of the golf course commenced thereafter. Building permits were not required for landscaping or grading activities associated with golf course construction.
6. The golf course has existed, operated continuously, and been relied upon by the City and surrounding development for more than thirty-eight (38) years.
7. Chalets possesses and had access to City records demonstrating approval of the golf course prior to filing the present appeal.
8. The Site Disturbance Permit at issue authorizes limited landscaping and site work and does not expand, intensify, or change the approved use of the property as a golf course.
9. The appeal is based solely on Chalets' assertion that the City failed to establish that the golf course was legally approved in the late 1980s.

INCORPORATION OF RECORD AND LEGAL AUTHORITIES

1. The City Council expressly adopts and incorporates by reference all legal authorities, arguments, analyses, and citations presented by the City Attorney in written submissions and in the presentation to the City Council, including but not limited to the PowerPoint presentation, correspondence, staff materials, and other documents admitted into the record in connection with this appeal. The Administrative Appeal, PowerPoint presentation, and other relevant documents, are attached to this Ruling as Exhibit A-J. These documents constitute the certified record for the Council's deliberation of the Chalets appeal. All such materials are made part of the administrative record and are relied upon by the City Council in reaching its decision.

2. To the extent any finding or conclusion herein could be supplemented or clarified by reference to those materials, the City Council intends that such materials provide additional support for this decision.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Midway City Council has jurisdiction to hear this appeal pursuant to Midway City Code and Utah law.
2. Land use approvals issued by a municipality become final if not timely appealed. Under Utah law, including both pre-LUDMA common law and Utah Code Ann. § 10-9a-704 (renumbered as § 10-20-1104 effective Nov. 6, 2025), challenges to land use decisions must be brought within a reasonable and limited period of time.
3. No appeal or legal challenge was filed regarding the approval of the Homestead golf course in 1987–1989. Any attempt to challenge the legality of that approval more than three decades later is barred by applicable statutes of limitation, the doctrine of laches, and principles of finality.
4. Utah courts have consistently held that final land use decisions may not be collaterally attacked years later, even where illegality is alleged.
5. The evidence in the record establishes that the golf course was lawfully approved through a conditional use permit issued by the City Council in 1987.
6. Allegations that Ordinance 87-4 is invalid, that zoning maps were improperly adopted, or that additional permits were required are unsupported by law, fact, or legal authority and do not invalidate the prior approval.
7. Even if any alleged defect had existed, such claims are untimely and legally barred.
8. The Planning Department acted within its authority in issuing a Site Disturbance Permit for landscaping work associated with an existing, lawfully established golf course.
9. Chalets' arguments regarding variances misunderstand Utah land use law. Variances do not authorize prohibited uses, and no variance would be applicable or required under the circumstances presented.
10. The Council finds no legal conflict of interest or improper conduct by City staff or legal counsel.

DECISION

The appeal filed by Chalets on the Creek Homeowners Association is hereby **DENIED**.

The Midway City Council finds that:

- a. The Homestead golf course was legally approved;
- b. Any challenge to that approval is long since barred;
- c. The Site Disturbance Permit was properly issued; and
- d. There is no basis in law or fact to reverse or condition the permit.

The Site Disturbance Permit issued to Homestead Group LLC shall remain in full force and effect.

RIGHT TO APPEAL

Pursuant to Utah Code § 10-9a-801, this decision may be appealed to the District Court within thirty (30) days of the date of issuance.

ADMINISTRATIVE APPEAL

Overview of Appeal Process:

I. Call meeting to order:

Narrative: It is 5:00 pm on December 2, 2025. We are assembled in the Midway City Council chambers for an Administrative Appeal. This is an administrative appeal from a final land use decision rendered by Mr. Michael Henkie, Midway City Planner relating to issuing a site disturbance permit to the Homestead.

On October 14, 2025, Chalets on the Creek submitted an appeal of the issuance of the site disturbance permit based on the argument that the Homestead Golf Course was no legally established in 1989.

The Midway City Code provides that the Appellant can appeal and Administrative Decision within thirty (30) days of the final decision. The site disturbance permit was issued on September 15, 2025, and Appellant in this case requested this appeal on October 14, 2025, so the appeal is timely.

According to the Midway City Code, the City Council shall be the appeal authority of all non-variance land use decisions in which the City Council has not first acted as the land use authority. This is a non-variance land use decision, and the City Council did not act as the land use authority in this matter. Therefore, the City Council is properly acting as the appeal authority. As mayor, I'm here to conduct

the appeal but will not participate in the deliberations or decision. That decision will be made by the Council.

The Standard of Review that the City Council shall use in this appeal is *de novo*. That is a legal term meaning “anew” or “afresh”. In other words, the City Council does not favor one side or the other, but takes an unbiased and impartial look at the evidence presented by each side, and then issues a ruling. However, the burden of proof in this matter is on the Appellant. In other words, the Appellant has the burden of proving that the Administrative Decision is incorrect.

The City Council, as the Appeal Authority, is required to interpret and apply the law and existing ordinances to the facts of the case to determine if the Administrative Decision was correct or incorrect.

The City Council is making a record of these proceedings. That means that the proceedings will be recorded and transcribed. All properly submitted materials from both sides for tonight’s hearing will also be made a part of the record. In addition, the following are also made a part of this record:

Documents Already Part of the Record.

1. Appeal letter dated October 15, 2025 from the Chalets on the Creek HOA.
2. Power Point Presentation submitted by Midway City.
3. Historical documents associated with approval of the Homestead Golf Course.
4. The existing Midway City Code is also a part of the record.

This is not a public hearing. The City Council does not take public comment during this appeal. It is a public meeting, but audience members shall refrain from interrupting in any way the proceedings.

The standard process of appellate boards and courts will be generally followed. All materials and argument received by the Appeal Authority must be relevant to the subject of the appeal, which is limited to the question of whether the Homestead Golf Course was legally approved in 1989.

The hearing shall be conducted as follows:

The Appellant shall have twenty (20) minutes to make its initial presentation. The presentation may be made by the Appellant or by legal counsel.

The Appellee (Midway City) shall then have twenty (20) minutes to make its presentation. The presentation may be made by the Appellee or by legal counsel.

The Appellant shall then have five (5) minutes to make a final summation.

The Appellee shall then have five (5) minutes to make a final summation.

The Appeal Authority may ask questions of the speakers. Questions and answers shall be included in the time allowances discussed above. Please keep questions short and to the point to allow the speaker as much time as possible to make their presentation.

A presenter may use less than their allotted time, but may not go over time.

The hearing shall be conducted in an orderly and respectful manner. No public comment will be taken, and no outbursts, comments or statements from the public will be allowed. Signs are not allowed in the hearing room.

The Administrative Appeal has appointed Brad Wilson as the timer. The Timer will keep time for each presentation, and shall indicate to the presenter when they have five (5) minutes left, when they have one (1) minute left, and when time is up. Presenters shall complete their presentation promptly on time.

Following the hearing, the Administrative Appeals Board may issue a ruling at the hearing, or may take the matter under advisement and issue a ruling within a reasonable time.

Generally, the administrative ruling will either uphold the final decision of the administrative officer (the Midway City Planner) or will overturn the final decision of the administrative officer. If the Administrative Appeals Board decision is to overturn the administrative officer, the matter would normally be sent back to the Planning office for processing consistent with the Appeals Board decision.

Appeal Hearing – Midway City Council December 2, 2025

My name is John Reeves, I'm representing Chalets on the Creek HOA, a PUD which is adjacent to the Homestead Golf Course along the 11th and 13th holes.

I am here today to appeal the Midway City Planning Department issuance of a site disturbance permit to the Homestead Group LLC on September 15, 2025 for the redevelopment of the Homestead Golf Course. We believe the Midway City Planning Department erred in issuing that permit to the Homestead Group as an existing nonconforming use since we have found significant evidence on the record that the golf course did not fit into the zoning code when a Letter of Commitment was signed in June 1988 and construction began in 1989 as follows:

1. Ordinance 87-3 (April 3, 1987) does not list a golf course as a permitted, conditional or other use in the R-4 or R1-A zones.
2. Ordinance 87-4 (December 3, 1987) amended the existing zoning code to create a new R-5 zone to allow for a golf course, however, it was not signed by the mayor as required thus the ordinance was never in effect.
3. Ordinance 87-4 does not explicitly specify a golf course as a permitted, conditional or other use in the R-5 zone. MMC 16.13.320 requires that a use be expressly stated otherwise it is prohibited.
4. Ordinance 87-4 does not include, or reference to a zoning map making it impossible for the city to issue a building permit or a Certificate of Zoning compliance for a specific location.
5. Midway City has a 1990 zoning map but no evidence it was approved by separate ordinance. Without a valid zoning map there would not have been possible to issue a building permit.
6. The 1990 zoning map is dated January 1990 and the construction began in 1989 so it couldn't have been used to determine zoning compliance.
7. We have found no evidence that a written building permit and Certificate of Zoning Compliance was ever issued by Midway City which was a clear violation of the MMC at the time (02.1101 and 02.1107).

Simply put, if the golf course was never legally established, it cannot be considered a legal nonconforming use now. Midway City failed to properly amend the zoning code back in 1987 to allow for a golf course to be constructed and operate within the original R4 or the newly created R5 zones. In addition, we have found no evidence to suggest that a building permit or a Certificate of Zoning Compliance was issued by Midway City in 1989 for the initial construction of the course (a direct violation of city code at the time). The city should have required that the Homestead Group LLC produce such evidence for a certificate of zoning compliance before the recent site disturbance permit was issued. It appears that instead of a building permit the city allowed the course to be constructed with only a Letter of Commitment from the land owners who granted easements to the Homestead Golf Club - even though that commitment was only so that a building permit could be processed. Without a building permit, there was no Legal Description of the Property, another fatal flaw in the process. Perhaps the most egregious issue is that a large portion of the course was constructed along Snake Creek and within the extensive Snake Creek wetlands without the appropriate permits as far as we can tell. To build this portion of the course would have required a dredge and fill permit from the US Army Corps of Engineers under the clean water act. None of the above legal requirements have a statute of limitations and every day is considered a new violation. These violations have been occurring over the past 30 years.

In summary, we believe the Planning Department greatly erred in issuing the recent site disturbance permit without two very important components: a legal description of the property and a Certificate of Zoning Compliance. A legal description is so fundamental - that alone would invalidate the entire permit. The certificate of zoning compliance would have evaluated all the zoning and permitting requirements previously discussed. Processing a certificate of zoning compliance would have required that the applicant provide proof that a building permit and a certificate of zoning compliance had been issued to prove legal establishment of the course when first constructed in 1989. If a certificate of zoning compliance could not be issued, the Homestead Group LLC would have been required to apply for a variance to the existing code to allow the course to be redeveloped. The Homestead Group would have had to explain why it is in the city's best interest to allow an extremely narrow course to be reconstructed in a dense residential area and a reputation for improperly and unfairly treating property owners around the course. In conclusion, we request that the City Council revoke the site disturbance permit issued on September 15, 2025 which we believe invalid for the aforementioned reasons. To move forward, the city should insist that the Homestead Group apply for a variance so that the golf course can be properly vetted and concerns from the various stakeholders be heard.

Chalets on the Creek HOA appeals the recent Site Disturbance Permit issued to the Homestead Group LLC by Michael Henke and Wes Johnson on September 15, 2025. Our understanding is that the Midway City Planning Department determined that a Site Disturbance Permit was the appropriate permitting instrument because it believes the golf course was a grandfathered nonconforming use. We appeal this determination because we have found no evidence that the planning department actually evaluated whether the golf course had been legally established in 1989 before issuing the permit last month. We are very surprised that the Homestead Group did not request such a certification before it applied for the site disturbance permit from Midway City since an original building permit for the golf course does not seem to exist. Also surprising is that the city did not require its own certification before issuing the permit or proclaiming to the public that the golf course was an existing use that was grandfathered in and couldn't be changed. It appears that making such a proclamation in the absence of an actual certification and not conducting public hearings could be seen as purposeful subterfuge to negate any accountability for placing a poorly designed golf course in what has become a densely populated residential zone (R-1-15). It has been used as an excuse to take no actions or set any conditions on the permit recently issued to protect the health and safety of citizens owning property adjacent to the golf course.

The way we see it, if the golf course was not legally established the Homestead Group would have been required to apply for a variance to the current zoning regulations. This would have required public hearings where the public could have formally provided input on what would

be needed for the course to continue to operate safely in a residential zone. If approved, the city would have been required to issue a conditional use permit, again with public hearings, to redevelop the course where specific conditions could be set.

Because of this, we believe the Planning Department erred in issuing a site disturbance permit for a golf course since there appears to be significant evidence on the record that golf course was not legally established as a nonconforming use when first constructed in 1989 as follows:

1. Ordinance 87-4 (December 3, 1987) was passed to create an R-5 zone to accommodate a golf course, but it was signed by the city Recorder rather than the Mayor invalidating the ordinance.
2. Ordinance 87-4 does not explicitly specify a golf course as a permitted, conditional or other use in the R-5 zone.
3. Ordinance 87-4 does not approve or include reference to a zoning map making it impossible to implement a construction permit for a specific location.
4. No evidence that the 1990 zoning map was approved by separate ordinance. Without an approved zoning map, a construction permit could not have been issued.
5. Ordinance 87-3 (April 3, 1987) does not list a golf course as a permitted, conditional or other use in the R-4 or R1-A zones.
6. The 1990 zoning map is dated January 1990 and the construction began in 1989 so it couldn't have been used for permitting purposes.
7. There is no evidence that a written building permit was issued by Midway City for the construction of the golf course.

Simply put, if the golf course was never legally established, it cannot be considered a nonconforming use now. Current zoning code prohibits golf courses in the R-1-15 zone. We request Midway City withdraw the current Site Disturbance Permit, suspend all work, and require that the Homestead Group apply for a variance to allow the golf course to be redeveloped within the current zoning. Once approved, the city should require that the course be permitted using a conditional use permit where the city will be required to conduct public hearings and establish conditions to mitigate the effects of operating a narrow golf course in a well-developed residential area where the use is prohibited because of the negative effects on people and property.

It should be noted that the Chalets on the Creek is in favor of the Golf Course Redevelopment, but we believe the owners should be held accountable for code violations during construction and take reasonable measures to protect the people and residential properties that are closely packed along it. We request that if legal counsel is required, that the City not use Gordon Law Group (Midway's usual city attorney), since the firm has exhibited a strong negative bias against Chalets on the Creek

HOA president Norm Henderson. In addition, Mr. Henderson was told by Ben Shakespeare in February that he already had had several ex parte conversations with Corbin Gordon regarding the site disturbance permit without the planning department representatives in attendance.

APPEAL -- HOMESTEAD

INTRODUCTION

- Chalets on the Creek (Chalets) has filed an appeal of Midway City's site disturbance permit issued to the Homestead based on the following theory:
- “Our understanding is that the Midway City Planning Department determined that a Site Disturbance Permit was the appropriate permitting instrument because it believes the golf course was a grandfathered nonconforming use. We appeal this determination because we have found no evidence that the planning department actually evaluated whether the golf course had been legally established in 1989 before issuing the permit last month.”
- THIS IS THE ONLY THEORY UPON WHICH THE APPEAL IS BASED
- Before addressing any of the substantive arguments there are numerous legal doctrines that apply to the situation, wherein neither Chalets nor Midway City may revisit an approval issued 38 years ago.



THE APPEAL FAILS BECAUSE THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS HAS RUN

- There are three theories upon which a statute of limitations applies, and none work:
- **LUDMA:** Under the current version of the Utah Municipal Land Use, Development, and Management Act (LUDMA) — in particular § 10-9a-704 — a municipality must adopt an ordinance setting a “reasonable time” (but not less than 10 days) for an appeal of a written decision of a land-use authority. In the absence of such ordinance, the statute prescribes 10 calendar days to appeal.
 - No appeal of the decision was filed.



THE APPEAL FAILS BECAUSE THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS HAS RUN

- **Pre-LUDMA case law** → Even if the challenger argues LUDMA doesn't apply because the decision predates 2005 (the year LUDMA was enacted), Utah case law still applies and case law at the time still required prompt challenge.
- **Salt Lake County v. Board of Education of Salt Lake City, 740 P.2d 284 (Utah 1987)**
- **Holding:** The Utah Supreme Court held that when a statute or ordinance does not specify a time to appeal an administrative decision, the challenger must bring the action “**within a reasonable time**”—and that this requirement is **strict**.
- The Court stated:
- When no time limit is established by statute or ordinance, a challenge must be brought **within a reasonable time**, which is determined by the **need for finality in government decisions**.
- It was repeatedly cited in later zoning cases to justify **strict, prompt deadlines**. See **McDonald v. Price, 784 P.2d 311 (Utah 1989)** (decision directly interpreting the pre-1987 rule). This case came two years after 1987 and explicitly applied the “reasonable time” rule to **land-use decisions** where no appeal period existed.



THE APPEAL FAILS BECAUSE THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS HAS RUN

- **Fox v. Park City, 2008 UT 85**
- The court held that residents **cannot collaterally attack a long-final land-use decision** by repackaging it as a new legal theory.
- After the appeal period expires, **the decision is final, regardless of alleged illegality.**
- **Gillmor v. Summit County, 2010 UT 69**
- The Utah Supreme Court held that:
- A land-use decision becomes **final and unassailable** after the statutory time expires.
- **Collateral attacks years later are barred**, even if the original approval was wrongly issued.
- **Creer v. Spanish Fork, 2021 UT App 88**
- A resident tried to challenge a decades-old subdivision claim on illegality grounds. The court held:
- “Final land-use decisions are not subject to later attack, even if the challenger alleges the decision violated the law.”



THE APPEAL FAILS BECAUSE THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS HAS RUN

- **General statutes of limitation** → § 78B-2-302 requires cases brought against “counties, towns and cities” to be **within one year**. § 78B-2-310: Actions against public officers -- **Within six years**. An action by the state, an agency, or a public corporation against a public officer for malfeasance, misfeasance, or nonfeasance in office or against a crime insurance policy in relation to the public officer's duties may be brought within six years after the officer ceases to hold the office. § 78B-2-307. Within four years. An action may be brought **within four years**: for relief not otherwise provided for by law.
- **Doctrine of laches** → this bars stale claims even when no statute applies
- **Municipal reliance interests** → 30+ years of operation is exceptionally strong evidence of vested rights
- **Bottom line: No Utah court has ever allowed a challenge to a decades-old city land-use approval to proceed.**

Whether you use LUDMA, pre-LUDMA common law, or § 78B-2-302, the result is the same: the claim is barred.



REVIEW OF APPEAL

Dear Mayor Johnson –

Chalets on the Creek HOA appeals the recent Site Disturbance Permit issued to the Homestead Group LLC by Michael Henke and Wes Johnson on September 15, 2025. Our understanding is that the Midway City Planning Department determined that a Site Disturbance Permit was the appropriate permitting instrument because it believes the golf course was a grandfathered nonconforming use. We appeal this determination because we have found no evidence that the planning department actually evaluated whether the golf course had been legally established in 1989 before issuing the permit last month.

Facts:

Homestead appeared before the City Council on October 5, 1987 and asked if they could file for a conditional use permit for a golf course under the Zones R-1-A and R-4.

The City Council found that the use of a golf course was similar to those allowed for conditional uses under the Zone and approved their request to file for a conditional use permit under these zones.

Homestead appeared on November 5, 1987 before the City Council asking for the Conditional Use Permit for the Golf Course and was approved.

December 3, 1987 the City Council approved the R-5 zone which allowed for condominiums around the golf course. THE GOLF COURSE WAS NOT APPROVED UNDER THIS ZONE.

April 17, 1988 the City Council amended the R-5 zone to add RV's and Trailers.



We are very surprised that the Homestead Group did not request such a certification before it applied for the site disturbance permit from Midway City since an original building permit for the golf course does not seem to exist.

- **Facts:**
- There are no building permits issued for landscaping, which misses the point – the golf course was approved as a conditional use permit and Chalets has had in its possession all of the documents that were just cited and that clearly establish the golf course was in fact approved before it filed its appeal.



- Also surprising is that the city did not require its own certification before issuing the permit or proclaiming to the public that the golf course was an existing use that was grandfathered in and couldn't be changed. It appears that making such a proclamation in the absence of an actual certification and not conducting public hearings **could be seen as purposeful subterfuge** to negate any accountability for placing a poorly designed golf course in what has become a densely populated residential zone (R-1-15). **It has been used as an excuse to take no actions or set any conditions on the permit recently issued to protect the health and safety of citizens owning property adjacent to the golf course.**
- **Facts:**
- **If the Chalets are going to make these types of accusations against public servants it better have real and uncontrovertible evidence and bullet proof legal theories. IT HAS NEITHER!**
- **One of the most offensive parts of my job is to see people accuse public servants of wrong-doing without any basis in fact or law. It is even worse when those same individuals are in possession of facts that prove otherwise that they refuse to read and consider. No one in the Chalets HOA has any right to accuse this City or its employees of “purposeful subterfuge” and to do it baldly and publicly when the facts in their possession prove otherwise.**



- The way we see it, if the golf course was not legally established the Homestead Group would have been required to apply for a variance to the current zoning regulations. This would have required public hearings where the public could have formally provided input on what would be needed for the course to continue to operate safely in a residential zone. If approved, the city would have been required to issue a conditional use permit, again with public hearings, to redevelop the course where specific conditions could be set.
- **Facts:**
- **This statement demonstrates the Chalets ignorance of municipal law and Midway City code. Even if the golf course wasn't legally established, we have established the time to appeal the approval has long since run, and even if it hadn't there is no such thing as a use variance. Variances are used to ask for exceptions to things like set-backs, height, etc.. There is no such thing as a variance for use. Either a use is permitted, or permitted with conditions (a conditional use permit), which clearly happened no less than 38 years ago.**



- Because of this, we believe the Planning Department erred in issuing a site disturbance permit for a golf course since there appears to be significant evidence on the record that golf course was not legally established as a nonconforming use when first constructed in 1989 follows:

- **Facts:**
- **There is no evidence on the record that the golf course was not legally established. In fact, the Chalets has uncontrovertible evidence it was legally established, and has chosen to bring this appeal without any basis in law or fact.**



- 1. Ordinance 87-4 (December 3, 1987) was passed to create an R-5 zone to accommodate a golf course, but it was signed by the city Recorder rather than the Mayor invalidating the ordinance. **Chalets cites to no legal authority that having the Recorder sign instead of the mayor invalidates the ordinance. There is nothing in the record that would suggest this is actual law or that after 37 years any court anywhere would find that the ordinance is invalid.**
- 2. Ordinance 87-4 does not explicitly specify a golf course as a permitted, conditional or other use in the R-5 zone. **It doesn't have to because the golf course was already approved under the prior zone.**
- 3. Ordinance 87-4 does not approve or include reference to a zoning map making it impossible to implement a construction permit for a specific location. **This ordinance was not the basis for the approval.**
- 4. No evidence that the 1990 zoning map was approved by separate ordinance. Without an approved zoning map, a construction permit could not have been issued. **Again, absolute conjecture without any basis or citation to law.**



- 5. Ordinance 87-3 (April 3, 1987) does not list a golf course as a permitted, conditional or other use in the R-4 or R1-A zones. **The City Council specifically addressed this issue on October 5, 1987 and found that the golf course was similar enough to other conditional uses to be allowed to move forward with an application for a conditional use permit which was granted on November 5, 1987.**
- 6. The 1990 zoning map is dated January 1990 and the construction began in 1989 so it couldn't have been used for permitting purposes. **See below.**
- 7. There is no evidence that a written building permit was issued by Midway City for the construction of the golf course. **Building permits are not required for landscaping.**



- Simply put, if the golf course was never legally established, it cannot be considered a nonconforming use now. Current zoning code prohibits golf courses in the R-1-15 zone. We request Midway City withdraw the current Site Disturbance Permit, suspend all work, and require that the Homestead Group apply for a variance to allow the golf course to be redeveloped within the current zoning. Once approved, the city should require that the course be permitted using a conditional use permit where the city will be required to conduct public hearings and establish conditions to mitigate the effects of operating a narrow golf course in a well-developed residential area where the use is prohibited because of the negative effects on people and property.
- **Facts:**
- **This is so ill-informed and non-sensical as to not require response. I have already shown how this has no basis in Utah Law or Midway City law.**



- We request that if legal counsel is required, that the City not use Gordon Law Group (Midway's usual city attorney), since the firm has exhibited a strong negative bias against Chalets on the Creek HOA president Norm Henderson. In addition, Mr. Henderson was told by Ben Shakespeare in February that he already had had several ex parte conversations with Corbin Gordon regarding the site disturbance permit without the planning department representatives in attendance.
- **Facts:**
- **There is no conflict.** First, Mr. Henderson has misrepresented his conversation with Mr. Ben Shakespeare regarding his conversation with him, and has done so for his own benefit. Mr. Shakespeare has never had a conversation with Mr. Gordon outside of meetings with Planning staff, and never told Mr. Henderson he did so. I won't call this an outright lie, but there is no basis for this allegation.
- Next, Mr. Gordon represented a party adverse to Mr. Henderson and did not show any negative bias towards Mr. Henderson beyond arguing forcefully against what he felt were weak and ill-formed legal arguments. Doing my job does not create a conflict.
- I would advise the counsel to make a finding that there is no conflict and move forward.



- There is no basis in law or fact to grant this appeal
 - The appeal is untimely
 - The facts clearly show the golf course was approved legally

6. The 1990 zoning map is dated January 1990 and the construction began in 1989 so it couldn't have been used for permitting purposes.
7. There is no evidence that a written building permit was issued by Midway City for the construction of the golf course.

Simply put, if the golf course was never legally established, it cannot be considered a nonconforming use now. Current zoning code prohibits golf courses in the R-1-15 zone. We request Midway City withdraw the current Site Disturbance Permit, suspend all work, and require that the Homestead Group apply for a variance to allow the golf course to be redeveloped within the current zoning. Once approved, the city should require that the course be permitted using a conditional use permit where the city will be required to conduct public hearings and establish conditions to mitigate the effects of operating a narrow golf course in a well-developed residential area where the use is prohibited because of the negative effects on people and property.

It should be noted that the Chalets on the Creek is in favor of the Golf Course Redevelopment, but we believe the owners should be held accountable for code violations during construction and take reasonable measures to protect the people and residential properties that are closely packed along it. We request that if legal counsel is required, that the City not use Gordon Law Group (Midway's usual city attorney), since the firm has exhibited a strong negative bias against Chalets on the Creek HOA president Norm Henderson. In addition, Mr. Henderson was told by Ben Shakespeare in February that he already had had several ex parte conversations with Corbin Gordon regarding the site disturbance permit without the planning department representatives in attendance.

Hi Brad, could you let us know the identity of the person providing legal advice to the city council regarding our appeal of the site disturbance permit issued by the planning department on 9/15/2025. We believe an independent counsel is absolutely required for our appeal to proceed and be fairly and impartially reviewed by the city council. We need to know when that person stepped into that role and whether that person was involved with the development of the hearing protocols that you submitted to us on 10/28 and the last minute amended procedures announced by the mayor at our 12/2 hearing.

The public hearing on 12/2, showed clearly that Mr. Gordon is the legal counsel for the city planning department. His presentation was aggressively adverse to our position that the golf course had not been legally established in 1989. He also came across as clearly biased against Mr. Henderson, personally. Having a position that is adverse to us and even heavily biased against Mr. Henderson is fine when he is representing the planning department, but there is a clear conflict of interest if he is also theoretically advising the city council who is supposed to be a neutral arbiter in the matter. Mr. Gordon, providing legal counsel to the city council to modify the hearing protocols on the fly during the actual hearing proceedings is a clear conflict of interest and a violation of our due process rights to a fair and impartial hearing before the city council. Further, it would seem that a neutral legal advisor would be cautioning the city council not to deliberate outside the public hearing.

As you know, at the beginning of the 12/2 hearing, the mayor announced two key changes to the hearing protocols that you had established and submitted to us on 10/28. These changes were memorialized in the "Overview of Appeal Process" that, I assume, was produced by the city council and announced by mayor Johnson at the beginning of the hearing. The city council must have had some kind of counsel to produce an overview document that was changed from what was originally given to us by you. As you know, the mayor announced the new policy at the meeting, without explaining to the public why the city council made the changes. Specifically, the mayor announced at the meeting that the hearing format was now de novo rather than on the record, a significant change that totally benefitted Mr. Gordon as counsel for the planning department allowing him to bring in new arguments rather than just rebutting our argument. The new procedures also extended the allowable time for the presentations and changed the rebuttal protocol (from verbal to written) also benefiting the defense. Further, there is no indication that the

city council was asked to review and approve these new last minute appeal procedures. Since there was no vote or discussion, it appeared to us that the decision must have been made by the mayor/city council outside the public hearing which seems to be a serious violation of the Utah Open and Public Meetings Act. If Mr. Gordon was serving as counsel for both the defendant (planning department) and the judge in the matter (the city council) that is a serious violation of our due process rights.

Before we go any further with our appeal, we'd like to put this due process and open meetings law violations to rest. We are not trying to be difficult, but the aforementioned issues are certainly concerning. We'd like to get your take on what we should do with the concerns expressed above. Re: Rebuttal arguments to the Midway City Planning Department Attorney presentation on 12/2/2025

Below please find the rebuttal to the presentation made to the City Council by the Midway City Planning Department Attorney on 12/2/2025. While the presentation by the Midway City Attorney was available, it certainly was not sent to me as claimed by the Midway City Planning Department Attorney. Further, it was not announced prior to the hearing that it would be *de novo*. Thus I could only assume that the Midway City Attorney would respond only to the claims and arguments I had made in my appeal letter dated October 14, 2025 regarding how the Homestead Golf Course had not been legally established in 1989. While my appeal went to Mayor Johnson and the Midway City Council, it appeared to us that the Midway City Planning Department Attorney had received our appeal letter with our arguments as well. Why the City Council provided the appeal to the Midway City Planning Department attorney is unknown. Knowing what we had prepared was a great advantage to him. Because Mr. Gordon raised new arguments (like I was appealing the 1989 permit to construct the golf course), I asked for and was allowed additional time to defend against the new arguments.

Our rebuttal is as follows:

Legal Establishment (slides 2-6) - The Planning Department attorney argues that our failure to appeal the permit in 1989 made the construction of a golf course in incompatible zones somehow legal. This argument is absurd on its face and the planning department attorney making such an absurd argument in front of the city council who look up to him for legal advice and who have no separate legal representation in this matter seems highly prejudicial against the appellant and may be unethical. Just because the city failed to do its job back then doesn't make it a nonconforming use now. If the use was never legal (it violated zoning from day one), it's an illegal use and not a protected nonconforming one, even with a permit. What is very clear from the record is that Midway City allowed the Homestead Golf Club to build a golf course in 1989 within land use zones in place at the time that prohibited a golf course. It is very important that we all understand the specifics of this apparent debacle that somehow Midway City allowed a course to be built on other's land within the already established residential zones (R4 and R1A zones created by Ordinance 87-4). Later the city council passed a new zoning ordinance establishing the R-5 zone that, inexplicably, did not allow a golf course into that zone either. The Midway City Council never passed an ordinance to allow a golf course within the R4, R1A and R5 zones. The planning department attorney argues that in 1987 the city council voted its intention to include a golf course as a conditional use in the R-4 and R1A zones but again, we fail to see the relevance of this fact since it is clear that those intentions never made it into ordinance. The Midway planning department attorney did not provide evidence of such an ordinance. Apparently, the city council has not seen fit to change the current RZ zone to allow for a golf course either. State law is very clear that municipalities have an obligation to specify clearly in its land use ordinances what uses are allowed. A use must be explicitly stated as a permitted, conditional or other use otherwise it is prohibited. It appears to us that the city council dropped the ball back in 1987 by failing to amend the zoning code to allow for the construction of a golf course in the R5 and RZ zones.

At bottom, our original argument that the original golf course had not been legally established stands unaffected by the non sequitur arguments made by the planning department attorney that because we missed the appeal deadline that the illegal use magically became legal. City employees and agents make mistakes all the time. Are we to understand from Mr. Gordon that when an employee makes a mistake, that it changes the law? In talking to local landowners, who, like

us, granted easements to the Homestead Golf Club, it appears that the establishment of the course was highly controversial and it could have been difficult to impossible for the Midway City Council to pass an ordinance allowing the course through the normal channels, i.e., with hearings and citizen input. From the record, it is clear that the Homestead Golf Course was not legally established in 1989 even though a permit or authorization may have been issued. Having not been legally established then, it can not be considered a legal nonconforming use now. As such, the course must be permitted under the current zoning code which still does not allow for a golf course in either the R-1-15, R-1-22, and RZ zones.

Chalet's concerns about how this illegal activity has impacted our property and owners should not be ignored because of this failure by the city to do its job back in 1987.

Conditional Use Permit (slide 7) - The planning department attorney argues that the City Council found on October 5, 1987 that the use as a golf course was similar to specified uses allowed in the R1A and R-4 zones. The city council on November 5, 1987 approved a conditional use permit for the Homestead. The facts are the following:

According to the minutes from 10/5/1987, the city council voted to approve that use as a golf course was a similar use to the other uses allowed as conditional uses in the R1A and R4 zones, however, city ordinance establishing those zones was never changed. The bottom line is that because the city zoning ordinance was never changed the vote had no effect and a golf course remained an illegal use within the R1A and R4 zones. Further, contrary to the claim made by the planning department attorney in slide 7, there is no evidence that the city council approved a conditional use permit for the homestead at the 11/5/1987 city council meeting. Thus, it does not appear that the golf course was actually ever permitted at all. This is consistent with our legal research that found in a 2000 court decision (Homestead Golf Club v. Pride Stables) that the course was actually allowed to be constructed through a Letter of Commitment signed by the landowners who had granted easements to the Homestead Golf Club. No Certificate of Compliance or a Building Permit was mentioned in any of the documentation supplied by the planning department attorney.

Certificate of Zoning Compliance (slide 8-12) - The attorney for the planning department argues that the city does not issue building permits for landscaping (page 4 second pane). That may be true now, but in 1989 Midway Municipal Code required a Building Permit to "...make a change in the use of any land (Sec. 02.1101)." As such, the midway city planning department appears to be wrong on the law. Also, the 1989 Municipal Code required a Certificate of Zoning Compliance for any change in use of the land. Such a certificate would have evaluated whether the zoning rules at the time would have allowed the development of a golf course. We have been given no explanation as to why such a certificate was not completed by the city or required by the Homestead Group.

Variance (Slide 9-10) - The planning department attorney observes that we incorrectly specified that the Homestead Group LLC would have had to apply for a variance if the nonconforming use status was removed. We agree and appreciate him pointing out that applying for a variance would be inappropriate. Rather, if the nonconforming use status was overturned, the Homestead Group LLC would be required to petition the Midway City Council to amend the current zoning ordinance for the R-5 and RZ zones to allow a golf course as a permitted, or conditional use.

Error (Slide 11) - The planning department attorney claims that there is no evidence on the record that the golf course was not legally established. He then claims that the vote of intent made by the Midway City Council in 1987 to change the zoning code as proof that the course was legally established. The planning department attorney knows full well that land uses must be specified in ordinance to be legal. As such, the vote of intent by the Midway City Council in the fall of 1987 did not change the existing zoning ordinance at that time regarding the R-5 and RZ zones and the code at the time did not specifically allow for a golf course.

Building permit (Slide 13) - The planning department attorney specifies at 7 that "...Building permits are not required for landscaping" inferring that a building permit was not necessary in 1989. This is a false statement when applied to the first construction of the course in 1989. By Midway City Code at the time, a building permit was required any time a person, firm, or corporation makes a change in use of any land within the territory shown on the zone map. There is no evidence in the record provided that a Building Permit was issued or applied for by the Homestead Golf Club in 1989. It appears that the only authorizing document referenced in anybody was a Letter of Commitment signed by all the parties granting easements or leases under the 1988 Homestead Golf Course Master Agreement.

Thanks for the opportunity to provide our rebuttal, I look forward to any questions the Midway City Council may have regarding our position that the 9/15/2025 site disturbance permit should be recalled and the Homestead Group LLC be required to submit a request to the City Council for a zoning ordinance change to accommodate the construction of a new golf course in the R5 and RZ zones.

Re: Objection to Non-Responsive Communication and Request to Strike

To Whom It May Concern:

On December 2, 2025 this Council sat in a quasi-judicial capacity and heard an administrative appeal of a decision of the Planning Department filed by Chalets on the Creek.

Due to claims made on the record that the Chalets had not received the City's presentation prior to the hearing, the Council allowed the appellant 10 days to submit a response to the substantive items raised in the City's presentation.

It was subsequently discovered that the City's presentation was sent to Norm Henderson, president of the Chalets on the Creek HOA three days prior to the hearing, and that his representations to the Council regarding this matter were not factual. *See email attached as Exhibit A.*

Further, instead of filing the allowed substantive response, Chalets on the Creek submitted the attached email to Brad Wilson, City Recorder, asking Mr. Wilson to provide him with information regarding this case and attempting to raise issues that are non-responsive to the City's presentation. *See Exhibit B.* This correspondence is not responsive, goes beyond the granted scope of the purpose of the response, contains new and novel arguments not included in its appeal or raised at the hearing, and should be stricken from the record under Midway City Code 16.26.60: The adversely affected party shall be required to present in its written appeal every theory of relief that the adversely affected party can raise in district court.

Should the City choose to consider the email submission from Chalets as the allowed response, the City responds to the items raised in the email as follows:

1. Objection to Hearing Protocols:
 - a. The same hearing protocols have been used in the City for the past 7 years. *See Exhibit C for the public record for the Watts appeal on December 13, 2017 wherein the almost identical Appeal Process was read into the record by then Mayor Colleen Bonner.* These protocols were not created on the fly, follow Midway City and State Code, and comply with due process.
 - b. Chalets was provided the email attached as Exhibit D outlining the appeal process, which follows the protocols set forth at the beginning of the hearing.
 - c. There is no basis for a claim of a violation of Due Process.

2. Objection to Mr. Gordon representing both the City Planner and the City Council:
 - a. Mr. Gordon does not serve as counsel to the City Council in administrative appeals. The City Council sits in its capacity as a Quasi-Judicial Board and is required to make its own findings and own decisions. It does not have appointed legal counsel for the appeal, just as a judge does not have appointed legal counsel in a court. The Council takes argument and makes a decision. There is no violation of Due Process.

3. Objection that the Hearing was De Novo:
 - a. The standard of review is contained in Midway Code – something the appellant has the obligation to understand and that was presented accurately in the way the hearing was conducted.

16.26.60 Appeal Authority

Except as provided in this Section, the City Council shall be the appeal authority of all non-variance land use decisions in which the City Council has not first acted as the land use authority. Only a decision in which a land use authority has applied a land use regulation to a particular land use application, person, or parcel may be appealed to an appeal authority. Appeal of such administrative decisions shall be made in writing to the City Council within 30 days of the administrative decision being issued in writing. **The adversely affected party shall be required to present in its written appeal every theory of relief that the adversely affected party can raise in district court. The appellant has the burden of proving that the land use authority erred. The standard of review by the City Council shall be de novo.** An adverse decision by the City Council acting as appeal authority may be appealed to district court pursuant to Utah law.

4. Objection to the Council allowing Chalets 10 additional days to respond in writing:
 - a. This accommodation was made based on the representation that the Chalets had not received the City's presentation and had sufficient time to review it, which turned out not to be accurate. It was made to assure Chalets did not have a due process claim.

The Chalets now twists this accommodation into a violation of Due Process because the Council gave it more time to respond in writing which it has chosen not to do?

- b. Further, the response is filed in contradiction to the accommodation provided to the Appellant that it would have ten additional days to respond to the substantive arguments made by the City. The response contains not one substantive argument in response to the City's presentation, instead raising new and novel arguments not contained in its appeal, which violates 16.26.60 and the Council's agreement to allow ten days to file a substantive response.

4. Objection to the Council deliberating in closed session:

- a. The Council can proceed as it chooses, but given this concern, the City has no problem with the Council conducting its deliberations in public to avoid any appearance of unfairness.

CONCLUSION: The Appellant was given time to respond to the arguments made in the City's presentation and has chosen not to do so – raising not one substantive argument, instead looking to procedural claims that have no basis in law or fact. The concerns raised are baseless, and have no bearing on the issues before the Council on appeal. The City requests that the appeal be submitted based on the record and denied.

ADMINISTRATIVE APPEAL

Overview of Appeal Process:

I. Call meeting to order:

Narrative: It is 7:00 pm on December 13, 2017. We are assembled in the Midway City Council chambers for an Administrative Appeal. This is an administrative appeal from a final land use decision rendered by Mr. Michael Henkie, Midway City Planner relating to the proposed Midway Springs Subdivision in Midway, Utah.

The issue that is being appeal involves the interpretation of Section 16.14.9 (C) of the Midway City Code.

Mr. Henkie issued his final ruling on the code interpretation in a letter dated October 24, 2017, which is made a part of the official record of these proceedings.

The Appellant disagrees with the Administrative Decision rendered by Mr. Henkie, and as requested this appeal. The Midway City Code provides that the Appellant can appeal and Administrative Decision within thirty (30) days of the final decision. The Appellant in this case requested this appeal on November 2, 2017, so the appeal is timely.

According to the Midway City Code, the City Council shall be the appeal authority of all non-variance land use decisions in which the City Council has not first acted as the land use authority. This is a non-variance land use decision, and the City Council did not act as the land use authority in this matter. Therefore, the City Council is properly acting as the appeal authority. As mayor, I'm here to conduct the appeal but will not participate in the deliberations or decision. That decision will be made by the Council.

The Standard of Review that the City Council shall use in this appeal is *de novo*. That is a legal term meaning "anew" or "afresh". In other words, the City Council does not favor one side or the other, but takes an unbiased and impartial look at the evidence presented by each side, and then issues a ruling. However, the burden of proof in this matter is on the Appellant. In other words, the Appellant has the burden of proving that the Administrative Decision is incorrect.

The City Council, as the Appeal Authority, is required to interpret and apply existing ordinances to the facts of the case to determine if the Administrative Decision was correct or incorrect.

This is not a public hearing. The City Council does not take public comment during this appeal. It is a public meeting, but audience members shall refrain from interrupting in any way the proceedings.

The standard process of appellate boards and courts will be generally followed. Written materials have been submitted to the Midway City Council and to the opposing party. That was required to be done by December 6, 2017 at 5:00 pm. I note that the written materials were to include a brief summary of the argument, along with any documents or other evidence that the party intends to present at the hearing tonight. The parties may have also included additional written materials, including letters, affidavits, or transcripts of prior hearings, but all materials received by the Appeal Authority must be relevant to the subject of the appeal, which is the interpretation of a specific section of the Midway City Code and the intent thereof.

Additional written materials that were not included in the submittals due on December 6, 2017, shall not be allowed to be presented at the hearing. Please do not refer to or quote materials that were not included in the packet.

The hearing shall be conducted as follows:

The Appellant shall have thirty (30) minutes to make its initial presentation. The presentation may be made by the Appellant or by legal counsel.

The Appellee (Midway City) shall then have thirty (30) minutes to make its presentation. The presentation may be made by the Appellee or by legal counsel.

The Appellant shall then have five (5) minutes to make a final summation.

The Appellee shall then have five (5) minutes to make a final summation.

The Appeal Authority may ask questions of the speakers. Questions and answers shall be included in the time allowances discussed above. Please keep questions short and to the point to allow the speaker as much time as possible to make their presentation.

A presenter may use less than their allotted time, but may not go over time.

The hearing shall be conducted in an orderly and respectful manner. No public comment will be taken, and no outbursts, comments or statements from the public will be allowed. Signs are not allowed in the hearing room.

The Administrative Appeal has appointed a timer _____. The Timer will keep time for each presentation, and shall indicate to the presenter when they have five (5) minutes left, when they have one (1) minute left, and when time is up. Presenters shall complete their presentation promptly on time.

Following the hearing, the Administrative Appeals Board may issue a ruling at the hearing, or may take the matter under advisement and issue a ruling within a reasonable time.

Generally, the administrative ruling will either uphold the final decision of the administrative officer (the Midway City Planner) or will overturn the final decision of the administrative officer. If the Administrative Appeals Board decision is to overturn the administrative officer, the matter would normally be sent back to the Planning office for processing consistent with the Appeals Board decision.

A letter setting forth the rules I have just read was sent to both parties and we did not receive any questions or objections. Therefore, we will proceed accordingly.
