The Mayor's Corner

If you've driven through town recently, you've probably encountered some road construction and I want to thank everyone for your patience as we work to improve Midway's infrastructure.

The work on Burgi Lane has taken longer than anticipated after crews discovered deteriorated conditions beneath the existing asphalt. While unexpected, the repairs happening now are necessary to ensure the road is rebuilt correctly and will serve our community for years to come. As work continues on the next section of Burgi Lane between Center Street and Pine Canyon Road, we expect to encounter similar conditions and will work as quickly as possible to complete the project.

UDOT also continues on the construction of the new traffic signal at Main Street and River Road. While construction is inconvenient, these improvements are important upgrades for the safety and functionality of our community.

If detours direct you through our neighborhoods, please remember that most city streets have a 25 mph speed limit. Following the speed limit will help keep our residents, pedestrians, and cyclists safe.

Thank you for your understanding as we work through these projects together and continue investing in Midway's future.

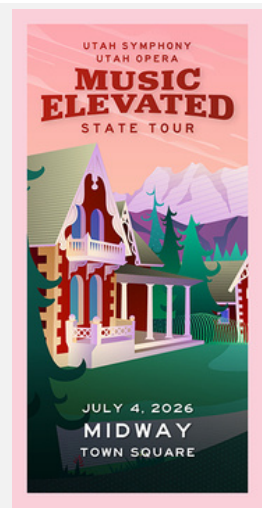

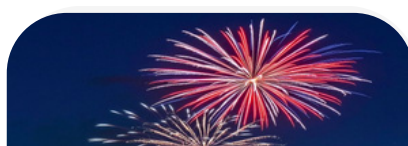

JULY 4TH ON THE SQUARE



Get ready for an unforgettable Fourth of July in Midway! As part of our America250 celebration, the Utah Symphony will perform a free patriotic concert on Town Square at 8:00 PM. This special performance is part of the Music Elevated State Tour and promises an evening of inspiring music, community, and celebration.

The day begins with Midway's traditional Fourth of July activities sponsored by the Midway Boosters, including a 7:00 AM Sunrise Service, followed by breakfast and the popular Kids Bike Parade. It's a great way to kick off a day of community celebration.

Make an evening of it by arriving early to enjoy food trucks and local dining options beginning at 5:00 PM. Bring your chairs or blankets and settle in for a memorable night under the summer sky.

Parking around Town Square will be limited on July 4, so we encourage residents to walk or ride their bikes whenever possible. Shuttle service will be available for the concert, with parking at several shuttle lots located just outside of Midway. Shuttle buses will provide convenient transportation directly to Town Square.
